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THE YEAR WITH **BALVIHAR**

Balvihar

The HTGW Balvihar program from its humble beginnings in 2006 has burgeoned into the current enrollment of 68 students, and three branches of study: Mythology, Language and Programming. The purpose of the Balvihar program; since inception, has been to create an immersive experience in Hindu Culture and Heritage, principally for children of Indian ethnicity, helping them understand what it means to be a Hindu, and an Indian at large.

The Balvihar program sponsors a five-course study in Hindu Mythology: **Tales of Pachatantra**, **Jataka Tales**, **Puranic Tales (Stories of Ganesha, Durga, Dashavatar & Krishna)**, **Ramayan**, **Mahabharath**. The classes are aimed at children in the age groups of 3 through 14. A five level **'Hindi Language Course'** catering to children 5 years and upwards was instituted in 2012. The goal of the course is to enable children to talk, read and write in Hindi. A two-year Computer programming course; launched in Jan 2015, is aimed at children 6 and upwards, and differentiates itself from other programming courses through the use of game development projects grounded in Hindu mythology. The programming class offers a novel method of combining the information from the Mythology classes, with current technologies, in it presenting the children with a fun opportunity to learn a new skill while retaining the core principles of Balvihar.

Balvihar's Capstone class 'Values'; as a part of our ongoing commitment to enrich and enhance the learning experience and retention, was envisaged as a 'Leadership' class. A class that presents 'Values' in the context of the life of various religious, political, industrial and cultural leaders from over the ages. The purpose of the class is to not only help the children develop a core set of values, but also, through real life examples understand how to execute on them. The children studied the lives and works of Religious Leaders like Adi Shankaracharya, Ramanujacharya, Buddha, Mahavir, Jesus, Zarathushtra, Basaveshwara, Ramanuja, & Madahvacharya, and Visionaries & Brave Hearts like Chanakya, Chandragupta, Ashoka, Harsha, Ajatshatru, Baladitya, Yashodharma, Bahubali, Kalidasa, Kabir, Eknath, Jnaneshwar, & Soordas. In the coming semesters, the children will be learning about Indian leaders from the middle ages, the Bhakti Movement, and the Indian Freedom Movement.

The general theme of the class discussions has been focused on illustrating that no matter the path and purpose of the leader, the same set of core values 'accommodation, anger, charity, delusion, desire, ego, friendship, greed, honesty, jealousy, non-violence, pride, resolve, respect' are key to their success. The concept and execution of this class has received commendation from parents and students alike.

Balvihar program is structured to promote holistic development in children. Art and writing have been incorporated into the syllabus to go hand-in- handwith the scholastic requirements. Balvihar sponsored competitions: *'Spirit of Balvihar'* T-Shirt design, *'Leadership & Values'* essay writing, *'Hindu Mythology Quiz'* and *'Shloka Recitation'* and Sports – *'Cricket'*, all of which attracted immense participation. Balvihar Sports aims to introduce children to games and sports popular in India.

The 'Seva' component of the 'Leadership' class introduced in fall 2015 focused on inculcating a culture of 'Giving' amongst children through participation in charity or service events has been a tremendous success. The students developed an initiative 'Host A Shocker' to invite Indian students of WSU to their homes to celebrate festivals with their families. An initiative that speaks volumes of their sense of community responsibility. The children have participated in various initiatives through the year to promote the welfare of the Wichita community and beyond. Some of the events hosted by the Seva class are "Back to School: WSU Drive" to help international students with essentials like winter clothing, furniture, linen & blankets, and cookware. The children volunteered at the Kansas Food Bank to help sort, stock & package, and at the Interfaith Inn to prepare & serve breakfast. 'Teach for Life' and 'Trees for Life' were two other programs that the children worked with. They helped with the development of instructional videos for the Teach for Life program. The class also helped raise funds for the Building Blocks Program of the Family Care Foundation. The Building Blocks Program helps ensure quality education for the economically backward. They participated in and helped organize a fundraiser with a goal of \$12,000, that was well exceeded. The Balvihar children independently raised another \$553 for Student Sponsorship and to help setup a Computer Lab. These funds were doubled through generous corporate Matches.

Balvihar is always on the look out to improve upon and expand its offerings in terms of the various courses and field service opportunities extended to the children. In keeping with this objective commencing in Summer of 2017 Balvihar will be offering **'Hindustani Music Classes'**. Interested students (age: 6 to 10) can register for these classes at *'balviharhtgw.org'*. In keeping with Balvihar's primary goal to kindle interest in Indian history & mythology and facilitate learning about our roots, starting Fall of 2017 the **'Balvihar Library'** will be open to all children enrolled in the program.

The experiences at Balvihar have served to enrich our students' lives and influence them in incorporating strong values such as compassion, empathy, integrity, and community involvement in their adult lives.
